HIGHLIGHTS

- Two new states reported COVID-19 in Nigeria Anambra and Niger. The total number of affected states in Nigeria is now 19
- Seventeen new cases reported Lagos (8), Katsina (3), FCT (2), Niger (1), Kaduna (1), Anambra (1), Ondo (1)
- Three cases previously included as Lagos state cases have been transferred to Ogun state. The three cases live in satellite towns in Ogun close to Lagos
- Presidential Task Force members briefed the press, with the DG NCDC particularly highlighting the need for social distancing




Fig. 1: Map of Nigeria showing the 19 states affected by COVID-19






Fig. 4: Age-Sex distribution of Confirmed Cases (wk9 – wk15)

RESPONSE ACTIVITIES

ON FEBRUARY 28TH 2020, A multi-sectoral Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) was activated at Level 3 – the highest emergency response level in Nigeria. This is led by NCDC. It also works with State EOCs for coordination.

- Expanded laboratory network for COVID-19 across the 6 geopolitical zones with 9 laboratories activated (NRL, DRL, IDH, LUTH, NIMR, ACEGID, UCH, ISTH and FETHA)
- Deployment of Rapid Response Team (RRT) to support response in all states with confirmed case(s). Currently 21 RRTs deployed
